## Food Vendor Guidelines

### July 24 - 26, 2009

**FESTIVAL HOURS** Gates to the public open at 3:00 p.m. on Friday. Set up is from 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. If you need access earlier, please notify us. The festival runs until noon on Sunday. There is a pancake breakfast on Saturday morning, and a "grab and go" breakfast on Sunday morning, both fundraisers for the church. You are welcome to start selling anytime after 9:30 a.m.. Please have your area cleaned and pack up by 2:00 p.m. on Sunday.

**VENDOR'S SPACE** Vendor's space is approximately 10' x 10' with additional prep space available. Vendors have access to a water truck for water supply, but there is no hot water or running water available. Shelf space in a refrigerated trailer is available, and will be kept locked at night. Overnight security is otherwise not provided, so please secure your items. The Forget Summer Arts Festival is not responsible for anything lost, stolen, or damaged at the festival.

**CLEANLINESS** You are responsible to keep your area clean and free of hazards. Please bring your own garbage can and bags. We will remove your garbage if you tie it well. Also keep in mind that dumping is not allowed. We will provide garbage service for the rest of the site.

**SIGNAGE** Please have signs with your menu and prices on them posted at your booth.

**WRISTBANDS & EXTRA WORKERS** All persons must wear valid wristbands to gain access to festival grounds. Those booths who have multiple shifts of workers do not have to purchase extra wristbands (we will require a list of workers and shift times to have at the gate). Workers will check in at the gate upon arrival and check out at the gate when shift is over. If workers would like to stay and enjoy the festival they can purchase a wristband at the gate.

**STARVING ARTISTS** We are giving musicians "festival bucks" to purchase from your booths. When you are ready to cash out, please hand in your bucks to Cheryl Richaud. You will be paid that amount by the Forget Summer Arts Festival.

**CANCELLATION** Should you need to cancel your agreement with the Forget Summer Arts Festival, please contact us in writing no later than June 15, 2009. Fees are not refundable after that date.
